Instructions for Paper-Setter:

4. The Map Questions shall be carrying 14 marks each (09 Marks for map work and 05 marks for Explanatory Note). For visually disabled students, the part relating to the Explanatory Note shall carry full marks.

3. Understand the major historical developments pertaining to the Establishment of the British Rule; Causes, Course and Effects of the Uprising of 1857; Social Awakening & Reform Movements; Freedom Struggle upto 1947; *Parjamandal* Movement in Princely States, and Formation of the State of Haryana.
4. Demonstrate the Major Excavated and Explored Sites of Harappan Civilization, Important Urban Centers during the Mughal Period, Major Centers of Uprising of 1857, Important Places connected with the Freedom Struggle, and Princely States connected with the *Prajamandal* Movement on the outline map of Haryana and also explicate it historically.
