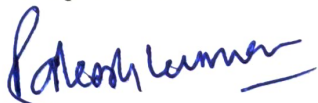
- **Date:** 29th July 2026 (Wednesday)

Further, it is clarified that those candidates whose names appeared in the merit lists published so far but could not take admission due to any reason are also eligible to participate in this Open Counselling, if interested.

Candidates who have already applied earlier need not apply again, but must remain physically present on the scheduled date and time for document verification.

Fresh applications are invited from **27.07.2026 (04:00 PM onwards) to 29.07.2026 (02:00 PM)** from interested candidates against the vacant seats. Candidates who have not applied earlier may submit their fresh applications during the above-mentioned period and participate in the Open Counselling, subject to fulfilment of the prescribed eligibility criteria.

Candidates selected during the Open Counselling will be required to deposit the prescribed admission fee on the same day to confirm their admission.
