1. This is to notify that all concerned that 2nd open counseling for the Master of Public Health (MPH) program against vacant seat will be conducted on 14.09.2026 (Monday) in the Gurugram University, Sector-87 Campus.
2. All eligible candidates must possessing a bachelor degree in MBBS/ BDS/ B.Pharm./ BAMS/ BVSc/B.Sc.Nursing/ M.Sc. in Life Sciences (Zoology/ Biotechnology/ Microbiology/ biochemistry/Home Science/ Genetics/ Environment Science) Pathology/ Physiology from a recognized University and has scored not less than 50% (47.5% in case of SC/ST/ Divyang candidates of Haryana only) marks in the aggregate of the maximum marks.
3. For admission of vacant seats during 2nd open counseling, priority will be given to CUET-qualified candidates having valid CUET score, followed by CUET marks (50% cut-off for CUET). The remaining seats will be filled merit of the qualifying examination marks i.e., B. Pharm./MBBS/ BDS/ B. Pharm./ BAMS/ BVSc/B.Sc. Nursing/ M.Sc. in Life Sciences (Zoology/ Biotechnology/ Microbiology/ biochemistry/Home Science/ Genetics/ Environment Science) Pathology/ Physiology.
4. The fresh candidates (who have not applied earlier) may submit their online application forms on the admission portal of Gurugram University.
5. The allotment of seats shall be made strictly on the basis of the candidate's merit, applicable reservation category, and the availability of seats in the respective category, in accordance with the University admission rules and applicable guidelines.
6. Firstly, the merit list will be prepared for reserved candidates. Later, in case seats remain vacant from the reserved category, they will be converted/offered to Haryana General open category/ All India open category candidates, on the same day, i.e. 2nd open counseling.
7. The candidates have to report in the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences (**Academic Block-1, Ground floor, and Pharmacy office**), Gurugram University, Gurugram (Sector 87) at 9:30 AM on 14/09/2026.
8. The admission will be provisional and subject to verification of original documents.
9. Applicable admission fees should be paid by 05:00 PM on 14.09.2026, failing which admission will stand cancelled. In the event of failure to deposit the fee by the stipulated date and time, the vacant seat(s) will be offered to the next candidate(s) in the merit list.
10. All SC category candidates need to submit a duly filled and signed undertaking as per the sample preform available in Information Brochure Appendix 'T'.
11. A candidate who has applied for a Haryana reserved category will be considered first in All India category and similarly, candidate of reserved category (SC/ST/BC-A/BC-B/EWS/PH/ESM) will be first considered in Haryana general category. In case he is not selected in the general category, he/she will be considered for the reserve category.
12. No entry of online application will be entertained after 4:00PM for the open counseling dated 14.09.2026. The merit list will be prepared only for candidates who report on or before 14.09.2026, 4:00PM.

15. **Applicants must carry one photocopy of all required documents along with a copy of the application form and 4 photos.**

1. The admission will be provisional and subject to verification of original supporting documents.
2. The students have to appear physically in Open counselling for admission to MPH. along with all relevant original documents as mentioned in the Information Brochure (2026-27).
3. The candidate should read the Information Brochure (2026-27) and notifications related to admission (2026-27) carefully before attending the Open counselling.
4. The candidates with re-appear(s) in the qualifying examination will not be allowed admission to the Programmes.
