Guidelines for Applicants:

1. Only candidates fulfilling the prescribed eligibility criteria in the information brochure available on university website are eligible to participate in the Open Counselling and need to fill the online application form on university admission portal.
2. Admission shall be made strictly on the basis of merit, eligibility, verification of documents, and availability of seats as per the University rules.
3. Candidates must report in person with all original documents and one set of self-attested photocopies of the document listed as following:
 - Matriculation Certificate (as proof of age).
 - Senior Secondary Examination Certificate.
 - CUET score card, if applicable.
 - Detailed Marks Card (DMC) of the qualifying examination.
 - Character Certificate from the institute last attended.
 - Certificate of Reserved Category and other related certificates, if applicable, as mentioned in the Information Brochure.
 - Aadhar Card.
 - Parivar Pehchan Patra (Latest Family ID) for Haryana Residents Only.
 - Latest EWS Certificate issued by competent authority.
 - Latest valid income certificate for SC/BC category or as per State Govt. instructions.
 - Haryana Resident Certificate, if applicable.
 - Documentary proof in support of respective Supernumerary category, if applicable.
 - Undertaking regarding Gap Year as per the information brochure 2026-27.
 - Two Photographs
4. Mere participation in the Open Counselling does not guarantee admission.
5. Candidates allotted a seat must deposit the prescribed admission fee on the same day of seat allotment, failing which the seat shall be offered to the next eligible candidate.
6. Candidates are advised to report at the venue at least 30 minutes before the scheduled reporting time.
