Haryana Film Mahotsav: A Celebration of Haryanvi Cinema

A two-day Haryana Film Mahotsav was organized at Guru Jambheshwar University, Hisar, Haryana. In this, artists from all over Haryana gathered and showcased their films.

It was an initiative of the department of Indian Cinema Culture and Department of Communication Management and Technology (GJU), affiliated with Vishwa Samvad Kendra Haryana.

3200 students took part in 24 workshops held in 24 institutes till December 2022. A total of 113 films received, and 57 short Films and documentaries were chosen for screening in this film festival. The films and documentaries were seen and appreciated by the chief guests and judges.

Deputy Speaker Haryana Legislative Assembly, Ranveer Singh Gangwa attended the program as the chief guest, along with Vice Chancellor of OPJS University Dr Jogendra Singh, and Vice Chancellor LUVAS Hisar Prof. Vinod Kumar Verma.

Anil Goyal, the director of the Aryan School in Hisar, presided over the event. Deputy Speaker, Ranbir Singh Gangwa said that, the aim of films should not only be entertainment but also education. He added, "Such a feeling should be propagated through films so that our nation is first and our duty towards the nation is first. "Shri Narendra Kumar, the head of Rashtriya Swayam sevak Sangh's All India Co-Promotion, made a special

presence at the programme.

Another positive aspect of this fest included two master classes which were organised to teach filmmaking to the people present at the film festival, in which Vinay Singal from the Stage app and Jogi Malang, the lead artist on the subject of acting and casting, gave detailed information about the genres of the film industry. On this occasion, the first, second and third best films in the professional category were awarded Rs 31,000, 21,000 and Rs 11,000 respectively. Awards were also given to the Best Film in the Short Film Category and the Best Film in the Non-Professional Category. In the Professional Short Film category, the first prize was given to Amit Kumar for Ek Aadmi Ka Nyota, the second prize was given to K.Vikas Vikk for Pushtaini, and the third prize was given to Shashank Virag for Safar. The first, second and third Non-Professional Short Film Awards were given to Suicide is not a solution from CMT GJU Hisar, Naina from Gurugram University, and Khanak respectively.

Out of those movies and documentaries there were 57 short movies and documentaries which were selected by Jury for screening. The description of the movies which have won prizes are as follows:-
