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Conference on National Education Policy at Gurugram University



12 January 2025: In line with national efforts to reform and strengthen the education system, Gurugram University has been actively promoting dialogue on academic policy and practice. Such initiatives aim to bring together diverse stakeholders to share perspectives and recommendations. With the objective of further strengthening Indian education, Gurugram University on the occasion of anniversary of Swami Vivekananda organised a one-day consultative conference focusing on the theme “National Education Policy 2020: Indian Education, Values, Culture and Your Suggestions.” The conference aimed to gather inputs from students, teachers, academic leaders and the general public to support the effective implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

The programme formally commenced with the lighting of the ceremonial lamp before the idol of Goddess Saraswati, followed by addresses emphasising the role of education and knowledge in national devel-

opment. Dr Jitendra Dahiya, Director of the Secondary Education Department, Haryana; Gurugram MLA Mukesh Sharma; and BJP District President Kamal Yadav attended as distinguished guests. Gurugram University Registrar Dr Rajeev Kumar Singh was also present. Following the inaugural ceremony, senior educationist Prof. D.P. Bhardwaj stated that the National Education Policy 2020 is a forward-looking initiative that will help India emerge as a global knowledge hub in the coming years.

Prof. Pawan Sharma, Director of IQAC at the Central University of Haryana, emphasised that NEP 2020 plays a crucial role in achieving the vision of Viksit Bharat 2047 and highlighted Haryana’s proactive role in implementing the policy, resulting in meaningful reforms across the education system. Gurugram MLA Mukesh Sharma noted that NEP 2020 is promoting Indian knowledge traditions among students and teachers, while BJP District President Kamal Yadav remarked that the policy strengthens students’ connection with moral values and cultural ethos.

The conference saw participation from principals, teachers, students and academic leaders from universities, colleges and schools across Faridabad, Mahendragarh, Rewari, Gurugram, Palwal and Nuh. Participants shared information on NEP 2020 initiatives in their institutions, along with the challenges faced, and offered practical and constructive suggestions.

She highlighted the importance of soft skills such as effective communication, teamwork, leadership, adaptability and a strong work ethic for long-term professional success. She also shared practical insights on building self-confidence, improving communication skills and preparing effectively for job interviews. The session was highly interactive, with Dr Sharma using real-life examples to illustrate how soft skills play a crucial role in the professional workplace. Students actively participated



and raised questions related to career preparation and workplace challenges. The talk proved to be a valuable learning experience, equipping students with essential skills to smoothly transition from academics to professional life.

One-Day Seminar on Haryanvi Cinema “CHAUPAL”

29 January 2025: Haryanvi cinema has gradually emerged as an important medium for showcasing the social life, traditions, folk culture and everyday realities of Haryana. Rooted in regional language and culture, it reflects rural narratives, social issues and changing lifestyles, while also preserving the state’s cultural identity. International Conference on Mental Health Organised by Department of Psychology

6–7 February, 2025: The Department of Psychology successfully hosted a two-day international conference, Psycho-Harmony 2025, in collaboration with ICSSR and USIEF. The conference brought together researchers, academicians and experts from five countries, including the USA, to discuss various aspects of mental health, workplace well-being and the impact of digitalisation on psychological health. The inaugural session, held on February 6, was graced by Gurugram University Vice-Chancellor Dr S.K. Tomar, along with Megha Sungar, Deputy Director, USIEF; Prof. Dhananjay Singh, Member Secretary, ICSSR; and other distinguished guests. In his address, Dr Tomar emphasised the importance of interdisciplinary research in the field of mental health and highlighted the need for greater collaboration among scholars, practitioners and policymakers.

The first day featured two technical sessions, during which researchers presented 85 research papers covering diverse themes related to mental health and well-being. Cultural activities and discussions were also organised, underlining the relevance of mental well-being in contemporary society. The concluding day, February 7, witnessed engaging discussions with



eminent speakers, including RSS Sah-Prachar Pramukh Sh. Narendra Thakur and former Haryana CID Chief Anil Kumar Rao (IPS). Sh. Thakur inaugurated a Panch Parivartan selfie point and spoke on the growing influence of technology, cautioning against its over-dependence, which can adversely affect mental health. The conference saw participation from over 50 national and international experts, with more than 90 research papers presented across six technical sessions and two panel discussions. Psycho-Harmony 2025 successfully fostered meaningful intellectual discourse on mental health challenges and innovative solutions, concluding with a call for sustained interdisciplinary collaboration and greater awareness to promote global mental well-being.

Career Counseling Session Organized on UGC NET Preparation



11 February 2025: The Department of English and Other Foreign Languages organized a career counseling session featuring Ms. Akanksha Puri as the keynote speaker. The session aimed to provide valuable insights to students preparing for the UGC NET examination and guide them toward effective preparation strategies. During the session, Ms. Puri

shared essential strategies and tips for cracking the exam, emphasizing effective time management techniques, key subject areas, and the importance of in-depth understanding and practice. She also explained the exam format in detail and highlighted the need for conceptual clarity to excel in the test. Encouraging students to focus on the core areas of their subjects, Ms. Puri stressed the importance of confidence building and regular practice with mock tests to enhance performance. She advised them to develop a structured study plan to optimize their preparation. A Q&A session was also conducted, allowing students to seek guidance on their doubts regarding preparation strategies and common challenges faced during exam readiness. Ms. Puri provided personalized advice, boosting students' morale and equipping them with the right tools for success in the UGC NET examination.

Gurugram University Celebrates 8th Foundation Day: Cultural Extravaganza by Students



17 February 2025: Gurugram University marked its 8th Foundation Day with a vibrant celebration, featuring cultural performances and inspiring speeches. 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हिंदी शिक्षा और रोजगार' पर विशेष व्याख्यान



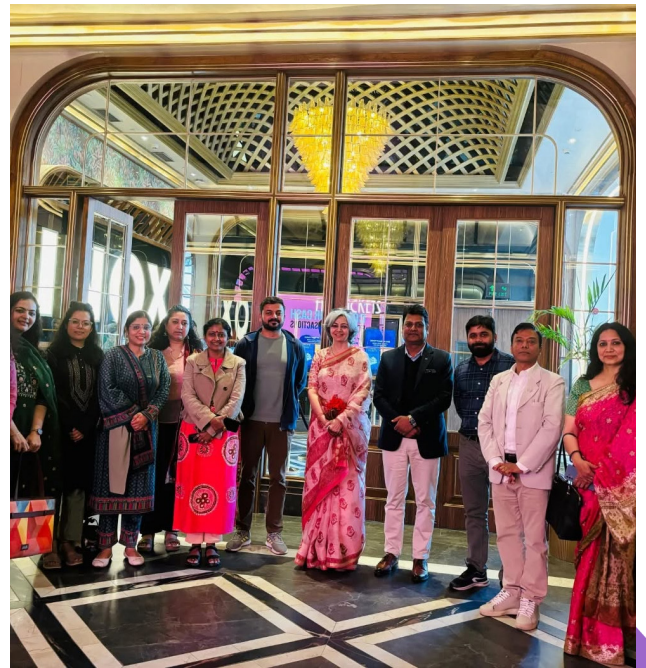

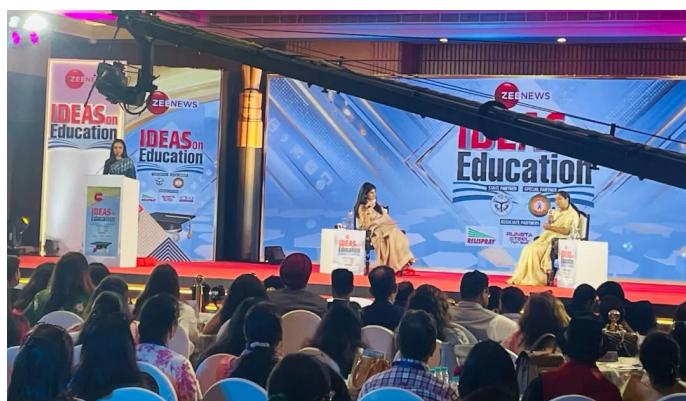
Faculty and Students Participate in Prestigious Zee Education Conclave
