## 1<sup>st</sup> ANNUAL REPORT

### Faculty of Law

To begin with the University has created a centre for post graduate studies known as Vikramaditya Centre for Post Graduate Legal Studies (VCPGLS) & started two Post Graduate Diploma Courses titled as (i) Post Graduate Diploma in Corporate Law & (ii) Post Graduate Diploma in Labour Law with an intake of 40 seats in each course. The Faculty of Law also started one year LL.M degree program in the session 2019-20 on choice based credit system (CBCS) with an intake of 40 seats.

**Specialization offered:** In LL.M Course/program a student has to clear seven theory papers in each semester including an open elective subject to be opted by the student as per their choice. Apart from this, each student has to write a research thesis known as dissertation/field report under the supervision of experienced faculty with a view to trend the students with research techniques.

The major specialization introduced so far include Corporate Law & Criminal Law. The complete syllabi of all the subjects have been prepared by the faculty members with latest amendment. The faculty members also prepared the syllabus of International Law specialization. The entire syllabi, scheme of examination & course contents of LL.M program has been properly approved by PGBOS and Academic Council.

Dr. Rakesh Kumari Malik has written around 7 Articles/Research Papers which have been published in Peer reviewed/Refreed Law Journals. Lovish Minocha has written around 4 research papers/articles and presented the same in National/International Seminars/Conference

#### **Students Participation in Seminar/Conferences:**

LL.M Students have actively participated in various intra departmental activities. They have also participated in activities that have been organised at the University Level. They also visited Geeta Mahotsav function organised by Govt. of Haryana

Students have also participated in various Intra Moot Competitions held in the University. They have also presented their papers from time to time with a view to gain practical exposure. The department have also organised discussions from time to time on socio legal issues prevailing in the society.

Two of the faculty members namely Dr. Rakesh Kumari Malik & Lovish Minocha have chaired the National Moot Court Competition i.e. "Justice Deepak Mishra Moot Court Competition" held at Geeta Institute of Law, Panipat. Lovish Minocha was also invited as Guest in Judgement Writing Competition held at Indian Society of International Law, New Delhi.

The faculty members gave the students "Pilot Study" i.e. empirical research to enhance their research skills, the faculty also decided to organised National Seminar as well as Jail Visit to Bhondsi Jail and Juvenile Homes in the month of March, 2020 but the same have been deferred due to COVID-19.
