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4. While sharing the details on the above points, Dr. Amarjeet Kaur briefed about the current courses offered and fees charged for each program. The worthy Vice Chancellor suggested reviewing the possibilities to increase the annual fees in each program and also to increase the intake for MBA Integrated.
5. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor while appreciating the efforts in successfully completing the project on 'Adolescent Health' undertaken by the department in collaboration with PRIA and University of Glasgow; proposed to involve Dr. Amarjeet Kaur in a future project of similar nature, where an organization is willing to fund the project through its CSR funds.
6. Dr. Amarjeet Kaur shared future plans regarding:
 - Organizing Guest Lectures by Industry experts (Minimum 2 lectures /workshop per subject)
 - Organizing one Industrial visit per Semester
 - Launch of Mentoring Programme after recruitment of regular faculty members
 - Implementation of Student Learning Plans (SLP) in MBA program
 - Strengthening Placements Activities
 - Technology embedded in courses through revision of curriculum
 - Soft skills and life skills embedded in the curriculum
 - Additions in Regular Faculty Resources
 - Increased interaction with industry through conclaves/conferences/workshops
 - Introducing certification courses in collaboration with ISDC/ACCA
 - Regular Faculty Development Programs
 - MDP Centre for training programs
7. Dr. Amarjeet Kaur, while presenting above points regarding future plans, briefed that the department is exploring collaborations with ISDC and ACCA for launch of certification courses in the area of Business Analytics and Digital Marketing; which will help the university in generating additional revenue. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor suggested exploring about Finishing School and also to review the collaboration with IHS for launch of a new program in hospitality sector with multiple entry-exit options.
8. Dr. Amarjeet also presented her idea to start a Management Development Program (MDP) Centre to train executives in the contemporary/functional areas of management and sought support to convert Kalam Kaksh into a round-tabled MDP centre, which was acknowledged by the worthy Vice Chancellor.
9. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor appreciated all the planned activities of the department and further suggested to initiate the process to procure at least two smart boards in the department to have access to technology-enabled classrooms.
10. Dr. Amarjeet Kaur shared the limitation of shortage of regular teaching resources and Hon'ble Vice Chancellor assured to recruit more faculty members soon.
