

Item No 3: To deliberate and approve the proposed revised LOCF based scheme of examination for MBA General, MBA Integrated, PG Diploma in Business Analytics, PG Diploma in Digital Marketing and MBA (Hospitality Management), applicable from the academic session 2022-23 onwards.

There was a detailed brainstorming on the proposed revised LOCF based scheme of examination for MBA General, MBA Integrated, PG Diploma in Business Analytics, PG Diploma in Digital Marketing and MBA (Hospitality Management), applicable from the academic session 2022-23 onwards.

The board approved the same with the following changes:

1. For MBA 5 Year Integrated, the nomenclature of 'Fundamentals of Income Tax' be changed to 'Income Tax Law'
2. For MBA 2 Year General Programme, the discipline 'Supply Chain & Operations' be changed to 'Operations & Supply Chain'
3. For PG Diploma in Business Analytics, No changes are suggested. The scheme of Examination for PG Diploma in Business Analytics is approved without any changes.
4. For PG Diploma in Digital Marketing, No changes are suggested. The scheme of Examination for PG Diploma in Digital Marketing is approved without any changes.
5. For MBA (Hospitality Management), No changes are suggested. The scheme of Examination for PG Diploma in Digital Marketing is approved without any changes.

Item No 4: To consider request of the Principal, Nirankari Baba Gurbanchan Singh Memorial College, Gurugram regarding revision in syllabus of BBA: (i) Adding Internships and (ii) Option to earn Credits from SWYAM and e-PG Pathshala etc.

(i) The Board after discussion came to a conclusion that the Internships should be added to the BBA Programme. The students will undergo summer training of 8 weeks with an industrial, business or service organization after completing 4 semesters.

(ii) The board approves that a student can earn 25 percent credits from SWAYAM and e-PG pathshala with reference to the University Grants Commission (UGC)'s concept note on 'Blended Mode of Teaching and Learning'. This note recommends that up to 40 percent of a course credits can be taught in blended learning mode.


Item No 5: To consider reducing the duration of Internship for MBA General, batch 2021-23 and MBA Integrated, Batch 2018-23 from 8 weeks to 6 weeks to streamline/adjust the staggering semesters due to Covid-19.

The Board after detailed deliberations came to a conclusion that it would be in the interest of students to streamline the staggering semesters due to covid-19, the duration of summer internship for MBA General for the batch 2021-23 can be reduced to 6 weeks and stands approved.

Item No 6: To consider the request of Principal, Govt. College, Sector-9 received vide letter no 679, dated 9th May 2022 regarding rectification of syllabus of 21BTTM601 and 603 and modification in 21BTTM705.

(i) The Board resolved that the request for rectification of syllabus of 21BTTM601 and 603 be approved.

(ii) The board further resolved that the request to include only 12 cases instead of 20 given cases in the existing curriculum received vide letter no 679, dated 9th May 2022 from the Principal, Govt. College, Sector-9 be approved in the interest of students and maintaining quality of teaching.
