**Item No.UG/PG BOS/13/01**

**Agenda:** To consider the recommendations of the DRC meetings held on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2024 regarding registration of Ms. Somya Angel, a Ph.D. Scholar as per clause 5.7 of the Ph.D. Ordinance no GURUGRAM PH. D./2020/1.

**Resolution/Decision:** The board discussed the approved the recommendation of the DRC regarding the registration of Ms. Somya Angel in Ph.D. program as per clause 5.7 of the Ph.D. Ordinance no GURUGRAM PH. D./2020/1.

**Item No.UG/PG BOS/13/02**

**Agenda:** To consider the recommendations of the DRC meetings held on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2024 regarding allocation of Ph.D. Supervisor/co-supervisor to the eligible Ph.D. Scholars from the batch 2023 as per clause 5.1 of the Ph.D. Ordinance no GURUGRAM PH. D./2022/2.

**Resolution/Decision:** The board reviewed the recommendations of the DRC and approved the list of supervisors/co-supervisors to five scholars in Ph. D program the the department from the batch 2023 as per clause 5.1 of the Ph.D. Ordinance no GURUGRAM PH. D./2022/2.

**Item No.UG/PG BOS/13/03:**

**Agenda:** To consider the recommendations of Dean Academic Affairs, GU and subsequently by the DSC held on 6<sup>th</sup> March 2024 regarding increasing seats for MBA programme from 60 to 120 by merging MBA (HM) in MBA and offering Hospitality Management as a specialization.

**Resolution/Decision:** (A) The board reviewed and discussed the proposed increase in the seats of MBA program by merging 60 seats of MBA (Hospitality Management) and further deliberated on offering specialized MBA in Hospitality Management and Business Analytics. It was resolved that 40 seats can be offered in MBA (Business Analytics) in collaboration with ISDC and only 20 seats in MBA (Hospitality Management) in collaboration with ISH instead of 60 looking at the admission trends of previous years.

(B) Board further resolved that since the department is going to offer 40 seats in specialized MBA (Business Analytics), thereby Business Analytics should not be offered as one of specialization in original MBA program and also the PG Diploma in Business Analytics can be discontinued. Further, It was resolved to offer super-specialization in MBA program, where students can go only for one area of specialization instead of going for major-minor option, if a student opts for it and this flexibility will fall under the purview of the NEP 2020 guidelines.

**Item No.UG/PG BOS/13/04:**

**Agenda:** To consider the recommendation of the Departmental Staff Council (DSC) held on 6<sup>th</sup> March 2024 regarding the revision in the curriculum of MBA, MBA Integrated and Post Graduate Diploma in Business Analytics as per GU ordinances, applicable from the academic session 2024-25 onwards.

**Resolution/Decision:** The board reviewed and deliberated upon the proposed changes in curriculum of MBA, MBA (Hospitality Management), MBA(Business Analytics), MBA (Integrated) in the light of NEP 2020 and GU ordinances in this regard and approved that the proposed changes to be implemented in the curriculum for the new batch 2024-25 onwards. Further, Board discussed and subsequently dismissed the need for approval of syllabus of PG Diploma in Business Analytics while referring to the previous agenda and approval thereto.
