



Letter of Intent

AIMST University (Malaysia) and Gurugram University (India)

AIMST University, Malaysia and Gurugram University, Haryana, INDIA) agreed to explore collaboration on academic related activities. This Letter of Intent allows for negotiations towards an official Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) following further discussions and sharing of information related to common areas of interest.

Scope

The scope of possible collaboration on academic covered by in this Letter of Intent includes the following categories:

- Explore on offering programme(s) on franchise and/or twinning basis;
- Promote staff and/or student mobility or exchange programme
- Joint seminars, workshops and research relevant academic activities.

This Letter of Intent is effective from **14th September 2019** as the date of execution by the appropriate officer of each signatory institution. The Letter of Intent covers a period of two (2) years from the final date of signing, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving notice of at least six (6) months-notice to the other party in writing.

This Letter of Intent is not intended to be legally binding and may be replaced by a formal Memorandum of Understanding when agreed to by both parties.
