

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

**FOR ACADEMIC COLLABORATION**

**BETWEEN**

**IILM UNIVERSITY, GURUGRAM**

**AND**

**GURUGRAM UNIVERSITY**

**AGREEMENT**

The Agreement is executed at Gurugram on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of Sept 2019.

**BY AND BETWEEN**

**IILM UNIVERSITY, GURUGRAM** having its Campus at Sector 53, DLF Golf Course Road, Gurugram, Haryana -122003 through Dr Sujata Shahi, Vice Chancellor (hereinafter referred to as "**IILM UNIVERSITY, GURUGRAM**") which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns) on the **First Part**,

**AND**

Gurugram University, Mayfield Garden, Sector 51, Gurugram, Haryana – 122003, though Dr Markanday Ahuja, Vice Chancellor, Gurugram University (hereinafter referred to as "**GURUGRAM UNIVERSITY**") which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns) on the **Second Part**.

**Purpose of Co-operation**

Based on the professional teaching advantages of both the parties, they shall create new platform to cultivate high level of training, research and consultancy projects in the area of Public Policy.

The cooperation between the two contracting institutions i.e., IILM University and Gurugram University is with a purpose to:

- Conduct training program on governance for Government officials.
- Conduct Joint Program / Course on Public Policy for students.
- Faculty Exchange program
- Take up research and consultancy projects offered by the Govt. and Govt. runs PSUs under the center.

- Create a Common platform / organize public lecture on the importance of law and Govt reputations on business & society.
- Provide a think tank/ platform to Government for validation of their concepts and policies.
- Organize certificate program for Government and Private sector employees.
- Organize joint conferences in the area of Governance and Public Policy

### **Content and Method of the Cooperation**

#### **Programmes/Courses**

- a) For Diploma/Graduation/Post-Graduation/other courses: Both Universities agree to adhere to follow the UGC or any central / state government guidelines.
- b) Structure of programmes: It will follow the structure as mentioned by UGC for degree courses and will be jointly approved by IILM University and Gurugram University.
- c) Courses will be suitably identified and will be designed as per mutual consent.
- d) Gurugram University will facilitate identification and selection of suitable students for subscription to courses and other identified programmes and IILM University would enable their training.
- e) Both universities will identify areas for FDP and Research.
- f) Both University will identify areas for joint conferences and concept validation.

#### **Tuition fees and Honorarium**

The students will register with Gurugram University for the respective courses and the tuition fees will be as per the norms set by IILM University. Scholarship will be as per norms published. Honorarium for the faculty will be as per UGC laid down norms.

Successful students of such courses will be given joint degree/diploma/certificates as per the norms mutually agreed upon.

#### **Structure of Management**

A joint management committee will be formed which would be responsible for the correct performance of these study programmes. All members of this committee should be nominated in a mutually acceptable manner by both parties. It will include four representatives each from IILM University and Gurugram University.

### **Rights and Obligations of both the parties**

Based on the scope of the MOU, both the Universities collectively need to prepare the methodology of instructions and its effective implementation in the programmes.

IILM University should be responsible for management of the students for the courses but both the parties will be responsible for necessary action assistance and guidance during their learning period.

### **Amendment to Agreement**

Any amendments to this agreement resulting from a change of circumstances or any other legal causes shall be agreed upon by both parties and effected by a resolution of the joint management commission and ratified by the Board of Management of IILM University and Executive Body of Gurugram University.

### **Arbitration of Disputes**

All activities conducted under this memorandum of understanding will be in accordance with all applicable rules and regulations of both the institutions and all applicable central state and local laws rules and regulations if there is any dispute it will be resolved mutually, failing which the matter should be referred to arbitrator who shall be appointed with consent of both the parties.

### **Effectiveness duration and Termination of Agreement**

This agreement will come into effect after signed by representatives of both universities the duration of the agreement is 5 years.

The agreement can be extended if both parties agree upon the extension of six months prior to the expiry of the terms.

The agreement can be terminated by each party by submitting a written application along with explanation which will terminate both parties commitments to future but not to existing registered students. Upon termination or expiry of agreement both universities should continue to deliver services to enable all existing registered students to finish their study of the programs.

Any Act or omission on the part of parties contrary to the provisions of Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006 shall be deemed to be null & void.

### Agreement of implementation

A detailed description of the scope of any cooperative activities by the parties shall be defined in one or more agreements of implementation, each agreement of implementation will include such terms as:

- (a) Elaboration of responsibilities of each institution for the agreed activities.
- (b) Schedule for Specific activity.
- (c) All Infrastructure will be provided by IILM University.
- (d) Intellectual Property ownership of the results of collaborative research activities.
- (e) Publication rights and appropriate credit to the parties and their respective personnel of the research activities.
- (f) Insurance and General legal provisions relating to the collaboration.
- (g) Any other terms deemed necessary for the effective management of the activity in accordance with all applicable law in the areas of education and reservations.
