Tech/BPT etc at par with the rates approved for BDS/B.Sc. Nursing/B. Pharmacy etc. i.e. Rs. 30/- per answer-book with minimum ceiling of Rs. 300/- as B. Tech/BPT etc are also the similar professional courses. But as the rates for specifically for B. Tech/BPT etc are not defined in these rates, the Accounts (Exams) branch by treating such courses as general U.G. course and being paid @25/- per answer-book with minimum 250/-. Accordingly, due to such deduction of payment by the Account Branch, the examiners are raising their objection and refusing to entertain the work of evaluation further. Item No.EC/40/05: To consider and approve the recommendations of the Selection Committee for appointment on the various teaching posts.

RESOLUTION :-

The Council approved the recommendations of the Selection Committee for the appointment of applicants to three posts of Assistant Professor in Economics and none found suitable against one post of Assistant Professor in Psychology. These recommendations were based on the interviews conducted on 01.06.2026 and 02.06.2026, respectively, commencing at 11:00 AM onwards. The advertisements for the aforementioned posts were published after obtaining approval of the observers, as per SoPs issued by the State Government.

Further, one post (UR) of Professor in Media Studies was published in February 2024. As this post was advertised prior to issuance of new SOPs by the State Govt. The University has placed the case before observers after interview which was held on 04.06.2026 at 02:30 PM onwards according to SOPs (2023) issued by the State Govt. prior to the publication of the advertisement.

During the Selection Committee meeting, the Chairperson, Department of Economics, emphasizing the needs of the Department, requested the Committee to recommend two candidates to be selected in General (UR) category. Therefore, the Selection Committee recommended the two candidates against the UR category and one candidate against the BCA category.

The one position of UR category in Economics shall be adjusted against a vacant post of UR category in other Department and roster will be maintained/adjusted according to the State Government policy dated 18.09.2025 in further appointments.
