Item No.AC/10/04: To consider and approve the recommendations of the Committee constituted to create the supernumerary seat for the wards of the residents of the villages who donated land to the University In Its Meeting held on 22.08.2022 (Annexure-C).

As per resolution No. 4 of its 9th meeting of Academic Council held on 19.08.2022 resolved to authorize the Vice Chancellor to constitute a Committee to discuss the provision of supernumerary seat for candidates belonging to villages' who donated land for new campus of the University and act accordingly. The Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor resolved that one supernumerary seat in all academic programmes except the programme approved by regulatory bodies provisioned for admission for the wards of the residents of the villages who donated the land to the University.

As per directions of the Vice Chancellor, the recommendations of the Committee are put up before the Academic Council for ex-post facto approval.

Item No.AC/10/05: To note the grant of provisional affiliation to newly established Colleges & new courses/increased intake etc in existing Colleges by the Inspection Board (Annexure-D).

It is apprised that the Executive Council had authorized the Inspection board to approve the report of the Inspection Committees and to grant provisional affiliation/increase in intake/introduction of additional courses to the affiliated colleges and to start new colleges. Accordingly, provisional affiliation was granted to various colleges for new courses/increase intakes/opening of new colleges etc. from time to time. At present 67 colleges are affiliated to with the University with different courses and intake (Annexure D).
